

# Wadsworth Barn

Wadsworth, Ohio

**The Past:** *The Wadsworth barn was built in 1922. Not only did it house animals, but it was primarily used for hay storage. The frame was a mixture of rough sawn and hand hewn beams. V-groove siding not only served as a decorative look on this barn but the grooves acted as channels for rainfall run-off. It was built on an embankment allowing livestock to be housed underneath and equipment to drive up onto the main level. Overall size of the barn was 20' x 28' and 22' feet in height. Some of the doors were a swing open type instead of sliding. The town of Wadsworth was established in 1814 and had a varied farming history.*
